Saint-Sauveur, January 18th, 2011 – Many athletes from Mont Saint-Sauveur's ski club faced off last January 15th and 16th, during Ski Mont Gabriel's World Cup event. It's with great pleasure that Mont Saint-Sauveur congratulates those International caliber athletes for a breathtaking performance.

Walking off with first place in front of his Canadian team-mate Mikaël Kingsbury, Olympic medalist Alexandre Bilodeau stirred up the crowd. Both ex-members of Mont Saint-Sauveur's freestyle club, Alexandre and Mikaël proved without the shadow of a doubt that the elite comes from Quebec. Cédric Rochon, from La Vallée de Saint-Sauveur, also gave a remarkable performance and ranked 13th.

What's more, the Dufour-Lapointe sisters trio, also ex-members of Mont Saint-Sauveur's freestyle club, finished in 1st, 4th (Chloé) and 15th (Maxime) place. Béatrice Bilodeau, also from the club, finished the competition in 16th place.

In addition to the moguls' duals, the competition offered aeriels, on a site that has been FIS approved in 2006 and is now worthy of any other world site, owing to its great athletes and public accessibility. After winning the Freestyle Nor Am silver medal last week-end, another Mont Saint-Sauveur / Mont Gabriel's club young member, Jean Christophe André, finished in 37th place. In the women category, Mont Saint-Sauveur wishes to congratulate Sabrina Guérin, crowned best Canadian athlete thanks to her 5th position.
